Al-Habshi won numerous local and international awards, including many international gold medals. Most notably, he won first place for two consecutive years (2012 & 2013) at the Emirates International Photography Contest. His recent achievements include first place and a gold medal at the Sharjah Arabian Photo, macro division, and being honored by His Highness Sheikh Dr. Sultan bin Mohammed Al Qasimi, Ruler of Sharjah. At the international level, Al-Habshi was able to win the first place in the scientific competition and specialized in micro-photography "Nikon Small Worlds" as the first Arab and Emirati to win this prestigious competition since its inception in 1975.

In the exhibition, Al-Habshi organized a series of individual and joint exhibitions, the most important of which was his first scientific photographic exhibition, in cooperation with the University of New York Abu Dhabi 2016, in the presence of Professor Claude, who covered the scientific part of the composition and characteristics of the composite eyes. Al-Habshi also participated in two international exhibitions in China, the last of which was the "Three Shadows" exhibition held in Datong City, China, as part of the joint cooperation between the festival administration and the Hamdan Bin Mohammed International Photography Award (HIPA). He Also Participated in the International Festival of Photography (Xposure) in 2018 in Sharjah. The latest exhibition in which Al Habshi participated was for "The Unseen", which was held at the Manarat Al Saadiyat in Sep 2019 in Abu Dhabi.



From the scientific side, Al-Habshi has made available some of his images of insects and their parts to several foreign universities for the purpose of performing new scientific projects and specialized studies. He has also provided specialized studies students with a set of these works for the purpose of academic research and graduation projects. National Geographic Al Arabiya Magazine, a major media platform, has continuously cooperated with Al-Habshi since 2016. Following their publication, he magazine used his photographs as the main content for their 2016 calendar.

His photographs have been featured in several local newspapers, as well as specialized photography magazines around the world. Additionally, they've been published in magazines focused on spreading awareness about agricultural pests and their negative impact.

"On the stage I am a painter, I am painting and creating"


"It is hard for me to say what I feel when I play because that is a mystery even to me. You find yourself in your very own world. The audience is in front of you. You see the people, but you are not aware of them. You gaze into complete emptiness. When you finish the concert piece, you are drawn back to reality. There are no other words I could use to describe this moment. This is art. A painter paints their work of art, and during a concert a musician paints their own art. On the stage I am a painter, I am painting and creating. I know no one and everyone ceases to exist, there is only me, my instrument and my vision." Bernardo Brizani

The 28-year-old cello player comes from a famous family of musicians and musical talent was basically handed down into his cradle. However, talent is not always enough. He worked hard for his success, spent endless hours practicing his cello, attended numerous lessons and had to make many sacrifices. When asked if he ever wanted to quit, his answer was completely clear: Never. Cello was his first love and that will never change.

Plans for the next year /

In July 2022, I will play a solo concert during the 70th Ljubljana Festival accompanied by the Slovenian Philharmonic Orchestra. In November 2022, I will have a solo concert in the National Museum of Slovenia in Ljubljana as a part of a concert series "Harmony of the Spheres" (season 2022/2023) accompanied by the Slovenian Philharmonic Chamber String Orchestra. I plan to release my first CD with famous classical music for cello and piano.



AAMI: Do you prefer big or small collections?

Tjaša: I like smaller collections, where it's all about the quality of materials and handmade, so yes, I see myself more in the second version, although we will see how everything turns out, but I definitely have the desire and will that are needed for big projects as well.

AAMI: Black & white or colours?

Tjaša: I love colours. They can tell so much. If creating a dress is a way of recording a certain idea in time, it's the same with colour. Your current feelings, the story you want to transmit... you can do it all with colours. They have an enormous power, just like every personality.

AAMI: Cotton or silk?

Tjaša: Definitely silk. Silk that caresses the body like its second skin. It provides a hint of femininity, elegance and glamour.

AAMI: Do you consider yourself a creative person?

Tjaša: Yes, I do and that is why I pursuit a path of independent fashion designer. I'm not limited in any aspect and I can produce my own unique dresses and collections. I do not like to repeat the dresses or to copy my sewing patterns. I like dynamic work.

AAMI: Who is your perfect customer?

Tjaša: I tend to create elegant, sophisticated fashion for women who know exactly what they want. This woman is determined to present her greatness to the world with a dress that suits her perfectly. She is a modern princess who lives in accordance with her attributes.

Kristina Vencelj

Kristina Vencelj was born in Nova Gorica, Slovenia. She had her first independent exhibition already as a high school student. At the beginning of her painting career, Kristina painted traditional motifs: still lives and landscapes, but her novelty of that time was technique and artistic approach. Her world is still full of contrasts and distinctly expressive colour charge, which is probably due to her thirty-year long involvement in astrology. After graduating from high school, Kristina was interested in almost all subject areas, but the desire for artistic expression was so strong that it prevailed. She enrolled in the study of painting at Ljubljana University (Arthouse College for Visual Arts), which she completed with a diploma thesis on the topic of Ornament in Painting (with an emphasis on the water lily flower).

Today, she uses various painting genres at the same time. She is still attracted to the water lily flower, which she mostly paints in an aerial perspective watercolour technique. The water lily is often stylized to ornament, the composition is set in symmetry, she juxtaposes the geometric shapes of a circle and a square, uses the number 4 (her numerological number) and places complementary colours alongside. The painter seeks a golden cut, and slowly, in the rhythm of the mantra, she paints thousands of small filigree circles, which illustrate water.

The geometric ornament is complemented with the atmosphere of mysticism, astrology and the dream world. At times, her geometry is shifted into the organic world, where the water lilies come to life in watercolour, some other times, her water lilies are dedicated to Monet. What matters to her is the inspiration and motivation that follow her life purpose, which is the Buddhist Doctrine of the Lotus Flower.

Kristina stores many of her paintings carefully, but seven years ago she wanted to create something that would be more accessible to end users as well, a greeting card and a gift and at the same time. This is how Kristina's Arabesques were created. They are Christmas and New Year's greeting cards, which have been sold out every year since then. The card is a very precise, persistent work that takes 10 to 60 hours, so buyers are advised to frame the gift.

Kristina also organizes and leads various art workshops for children, adolescents and adults. When the workshops are finished, she organizes an exhibition and the new artists are awarded with diplomas. As a result of this, the general public gets to know them. She has had many group and solo exhibitions. Her paintings adorn many public and private spaces. She lives and works in Nova Gorica (Slovenia).



Natalija Horjak

Natalija Horjak was born in Slovenia in 1990. She has a degree in economics and is an optician by profession. She is an enthusiast of art, shamanism, healing and bioenergy. She is a lover of culture and ancient art, and would like to work with international galleries and museums, as well as with business and private individuals. She has worked with the Institute Atelje Art Murn International on several projects and exhibitions in Ljubljana, Prague, Ibiza and Amsterdam. The presented artwork, this marine, sandy creation, is made on canvas with acrylic paints and features Swarovski elements, colourful tourmaline minerals and shells from the Slovenian coast. The spiritual meaning is money, success, the law of attraction and the highest enlightenment of Creation-God. It represents the path of peace, warmth, freshness, light, wisdom, mental and physical renewal.



Vethan Sautour

Vethan Sautour is a French artist, whose work tackles themes related to animal extinction, environmental concerns and the evolution of contemporary art. Spanning from photography, to sculpture and painting, this prolific artist's work is in perpetual evolution and the importance of conveying messages through her art is paramount to both her conceptual and aesthetic artistic approach. Based in Austria and the UAE, she has exhibited in numerous hotspots such as Paris, London, Berlin, Zürich, throughout Italy, Slovenia and South Korea. In March 2020, she won the Italian Kalos Prize for a painting from the Medici series. Her international education has imbued her work with a wide array of cultural influences: from traditional nihonga Japanese artists to contemporary ones such as Morita Rieko and Tomoko Konoike, from Renaissance Italian art and Mannerism to Andy Warhol and Pop Art, from modern propaganda posters to socially conscious artists, such as Ai Weiwei and Jack B. Yeats.

The present series is a reflection on contemporary art, the latter which, due to a lack of critical distance and the impact of its ever-increasing financial value, still struggles to define itself. The artist picked Renaissance art - a clearly defined, pivotal movement in history – and more specifically one of its main patrons, the Medici, to establish a contrast with the current strife to define artistic quality. To do so, the artist drew from some of the most famous works of pop art and modern propaganda, whilst purposefully simplifying these famous portraits in a near industrial manner reminiscent of serigraphy. The choice of making handmade, serigraphic looking paintings is also a representation of our current era, in which the human's imperfect strokes is rivaled by machine-made renderings.







Razzak Jubayer

Razzak Jubayer is an academic painter and experimental photographer. He concluded the Academy of arts in the former Yugoslavia at the University of Priština and now he lives and works in Piran, Slovenia. Piran is a place of inspiration and spiritual transformation for Razzak. He is using mixed techniques for painting, such as acrylic paints, aquarelle and airbrush techniques. Sophism is his way of life and in his endeavour to search for beauty, he translates poetry into colours. His visual style is mainly modern Dadaism. His frequent collaborations are with the group E20 GAIA from Perugia, Sensation Kunst from Klagenfurt and with the AAMI international institute, based in Slovenia. Since 2012 he runs art gallery Runa, where he is regularly organizing artistic exhibitions every month. The principle of his art is honouring beauty. Some of his recent art exhibitions were held in Vienna, Ljubljana, London and Prague and he is always open to explore new opportunities.




