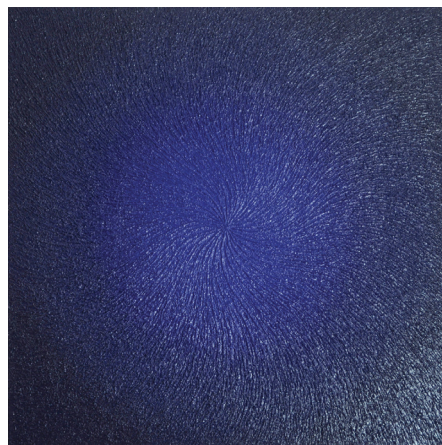
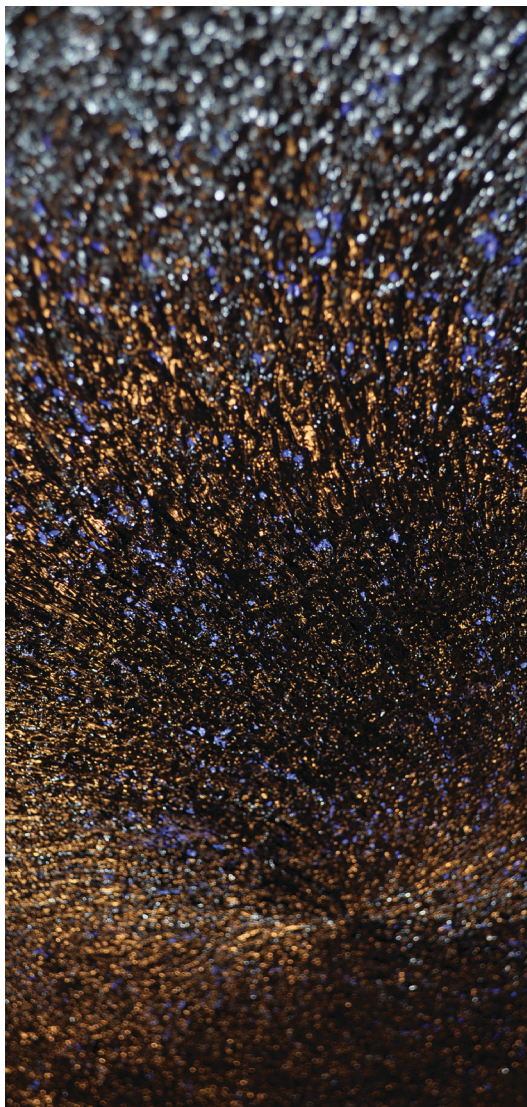
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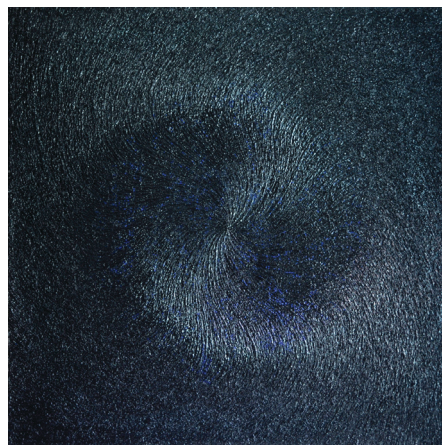

The Katie Feygie Art Gallery was founded in Prague (Czech Republic) in 1996. Since its opening it specializes in contemporary fine arts (graphics, paintings, and sculptures), modern art, and fine arts. Since 2000, the Katie Feygie Art Gallery holds annual contemporary art auctions in the USA, Israel, and Prague.

Besides exhibitions, the gallery holds art shows of contemporary art in Europe, Asia, and the USA. In 2014 the Katie Feygie Art Gallery formed the “Katie Feygie Art Club” for collectors and art lovers from all around the world. Since 1996, the Katie Feygie Art Gallery has opened more than 300 exhibitions and more than 260 auctions.

In 2013, 2015, and 2017, the Katie Feygie Art Gallery was awarded the People Vote award as the best commercial gallery in Prague. In 2022, the Katie Feygie Art Gallery became the Member of the Czech Chamber of Commerce and is counted as the leading privately-owned art gallery in Prague.

Kirill Postovit is a well-known contemporary academic painter and sculptor. Since 1996, he has been a member of the Academic Artists Association of Israel. His work is versatile but always easily recognizable. In his sculptural, graphics and painting works, the profound philosophy of every painting and sculpture can be felt in addition to professionalism. Since 1990, there have been more than 260 personal exhibitions by Kirill Postovit of his works. “While it is not inappropriate to link Postovit with surrealism, which had a strong following in Czechoslovakia, the element of whimsy, of the fantastical, and a predilection for symbolic modes of representation, also recalls the work of Marc Chagall.”(an extract from The Edges Of Art Catalog introduction prepared by Prof. David Lomas, Professor of Art History, Manchester University, UK June 2019).

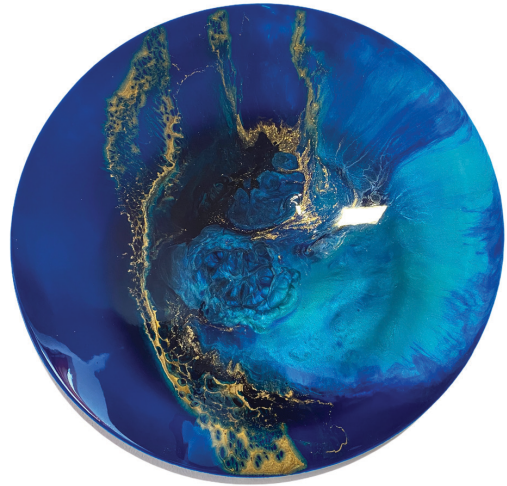

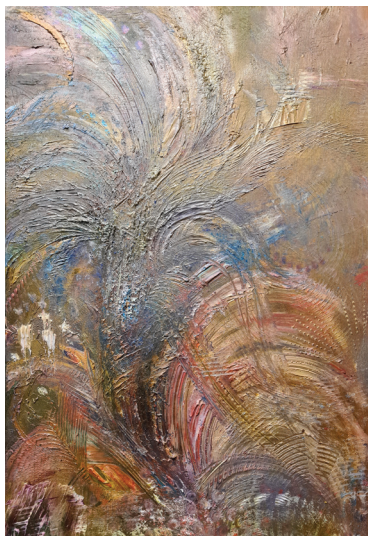

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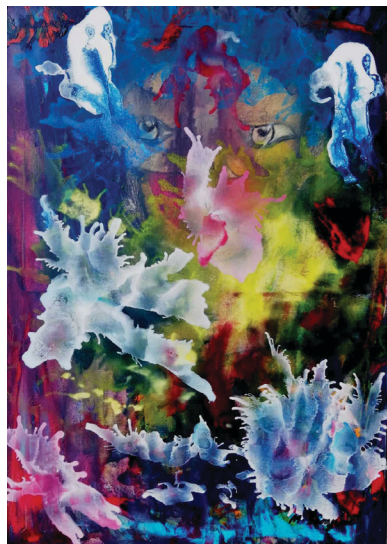

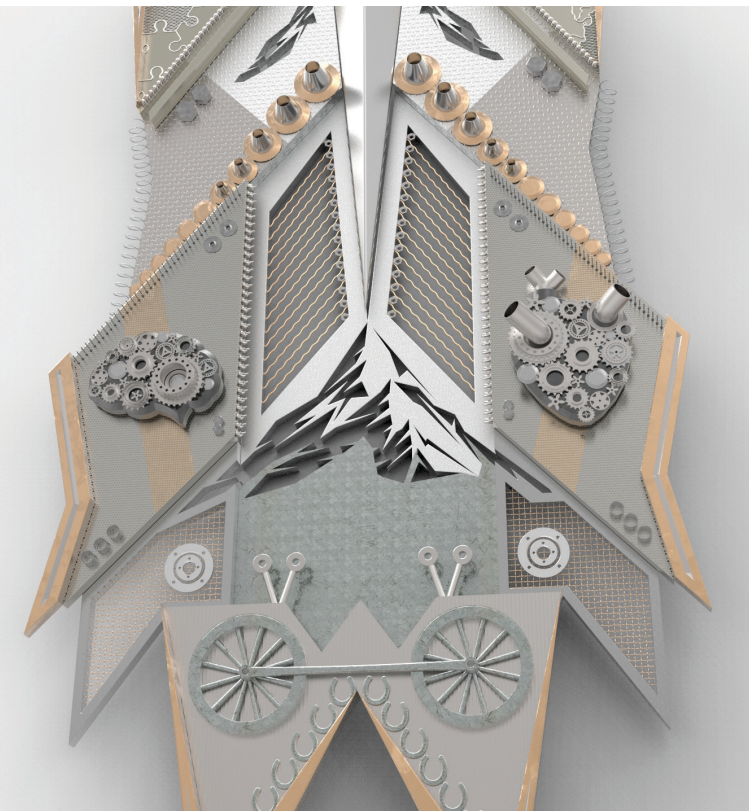


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The MDM Company has been active in the area of stainless steel and aluminium products and services for over 40 years.

The installation “Making Dream Monuments” is not only a monument to the events that marked the development of the company MDM throughout history, but also focuses on current operations and predicts the bright future and development of the company.

The artwork, designed by Miha Murn, a versatile artist and owner of AAMI Corporation, consists of 7 main parts. The art installation, made by professionals from the company MDM, measures more than 9 m in height and more than 3 m in width. The seven parts of the installation consist of a relief about 50 cm deep.

The installation is made of different materials - steel, aluminum and iron, which were processed by various processes such as laser cutting, bending, welding, gluing, painting and other.

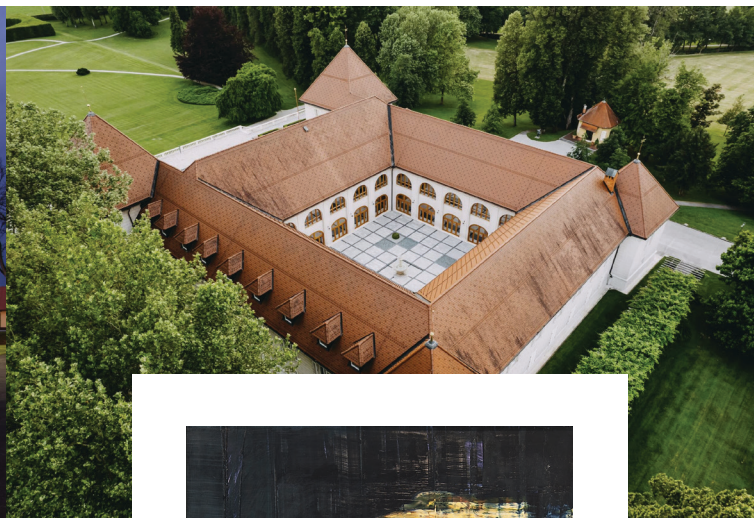
